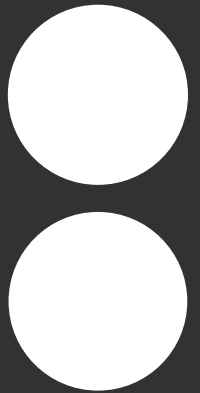

FENIX CLEANING GUIDELINES

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE OF NANOTECH MATERIALS

Start mild – always test first.

FENIX has a unique microstructure that reflects light in a special way. This gives the surface a matte appearance. To maintain this property, it is important to keep the structure properly clean.

In this document you will find simple but essential guidelines for daily and thorough maintenance. Regular cleaning according to these instructions will keep your FENIX surface beautiful for years to come.

1. Daily cleaning and stain removal

Warm water is usually sufficient for daily cleaning. FENIX is a strong material and resistant to common household cleaners such as:

- All-purpose cleaners
- Disinfectants
- Degreasers
- Lime removers
- Acetone (only if necessary, always follow the safety instructions on the packaging).



2. Liste courte des interdictions

- Crèmes abrasives
- Éponges à récurer ou paille de fer
- Brosses dures

Elles peuvent endommager la microstructure et provoquer des taches brillantes sur la surface mate.

3. Thorough cleaning (for overdue maintenance)

Step 1: Degreasing

- Spray the entire surface with kitchen degreaser.
- Rub off dirt with a soft cloth and warm water.
- Rinse with plenty of warm water.
- Dry with a clean cloth.

Step 2: Descale

- Treat the surface with an anti-scaling agent.
- Rub off any lime residue with warm water and a cloth.
- Rinse again and dry carefully.

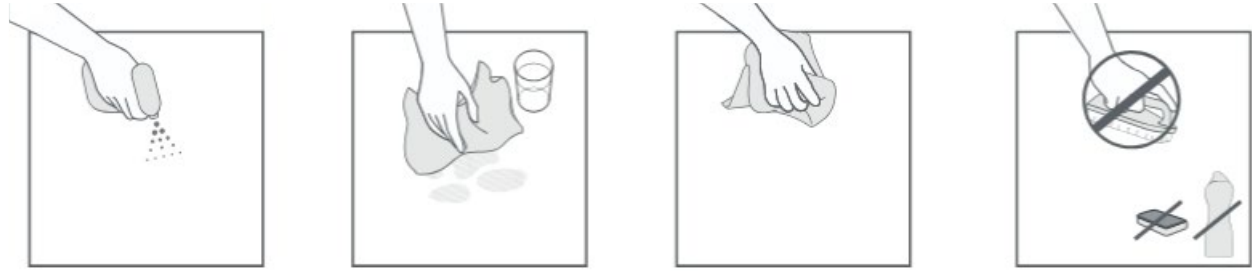
Step 3: Deep cleaning

- Using a melamine sponge, make small, circular motions across the entire surface to clean deep into the structure.
- Rinse again with warm water.
- Dry with a clean cloth.
- If necessary, use acetone topically on stubborn stains.

>> Always follow the safety instructions on the package.

>> Repeat rinsing and drying after using acetone.

4. Étapes de nettoyage

- Choisissez un produit de nettoyage approprié.
- Utilisez un chiffon doux ou une éponge en mélamine (également appelée « éponge magique »).
- Rincez soigneusement la surface à l'eau chaude.
- Séchez avec un chiffon propre et doux.

>> Cela permet d'éviter les dépôts de calcaire et d'éliminer les résidus de saleté et/ou de produits de nettoyage.

5. Conseils importants en un coup d'œil

- Nettoyage FENIX = nettoyage de la microstructure
- N'utilisez que des produits de nettoyage doux
- Rincez et séchez toujours soigneusement après
- Évitez les taches brillantes en ne ponçant pas.

Si la surface de FENIX n'a pas été nettoyée pendant une période prolongée, des particules de saleté peuvent s'accumuler dans la microstructure. Cela peut affecter l'aspect de la surface. Dans ce cas, suivez les étapes suivantes pour un nettoyage en profondeur.
