

CLEANING OF LACQUERED STEEL SHEET

Always start gently and test in an inconspicuous area first.

When cleaning lacquered steel sheets, it is important to ensure that the cleaning agents used do not damage or affect the material or its surface treatment. Only neutral cleaning agents with a pH value between 6 and 8 are permitted. These agents must also be non-abrasive. Permitted examples include:

- Mild soap solutions
- Neutral all-purpose cleaners (without solvents)
- Soft cloths or sponges (such as microfiber cloths)
- Lukewarm water

The use of abrasive or aggressive products such as steel wool, sandpaper, solvents, or caustic chemicals is not allowed.



Always clean with gentle movements and rinse with clean water to remove any cleaning residue. Dry the surface with a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent staining.
