

CLEANING ADVICE FOR PVC ROLLER SHUTTERS

Cleaning advice for PVC roller shutters

These cleaning guidelines apply to PVC roller shutters, specifically for the following types:

- SE 16 PVC (plain, textured, and decorative)
- SE 22 PVC (plain, decorative, and translucent)
- SE 4 PVC (plain, textured, and decorative)
- E4 PVC (plain and decorative)

Cleaning advice

Preferably use the same mild method as for PP roller shutters:
soapy water + a soft cloth.



Avoid the following when cleaning
PVC and PP roller shutters:

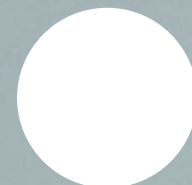
Solvents such as acetone

(can cause chemical reactions with PVC; dull surface on PP)

Abrasive materials such as scouring pads or abrasive cleaners
(risk of scratching both materials)

Aggressive cleaning agents

(may damage or discolor the surface)
